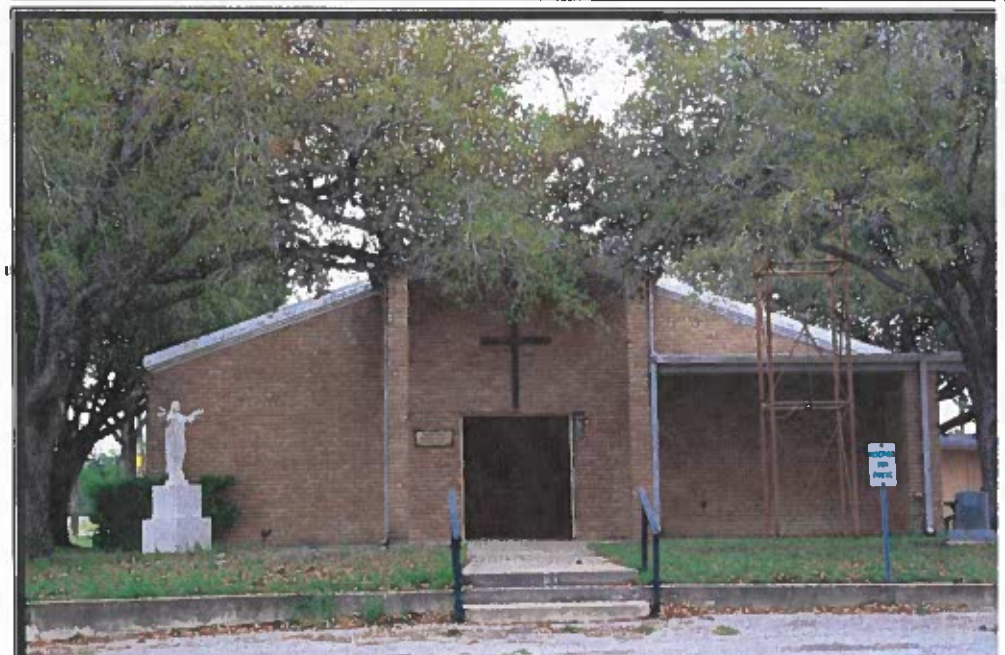
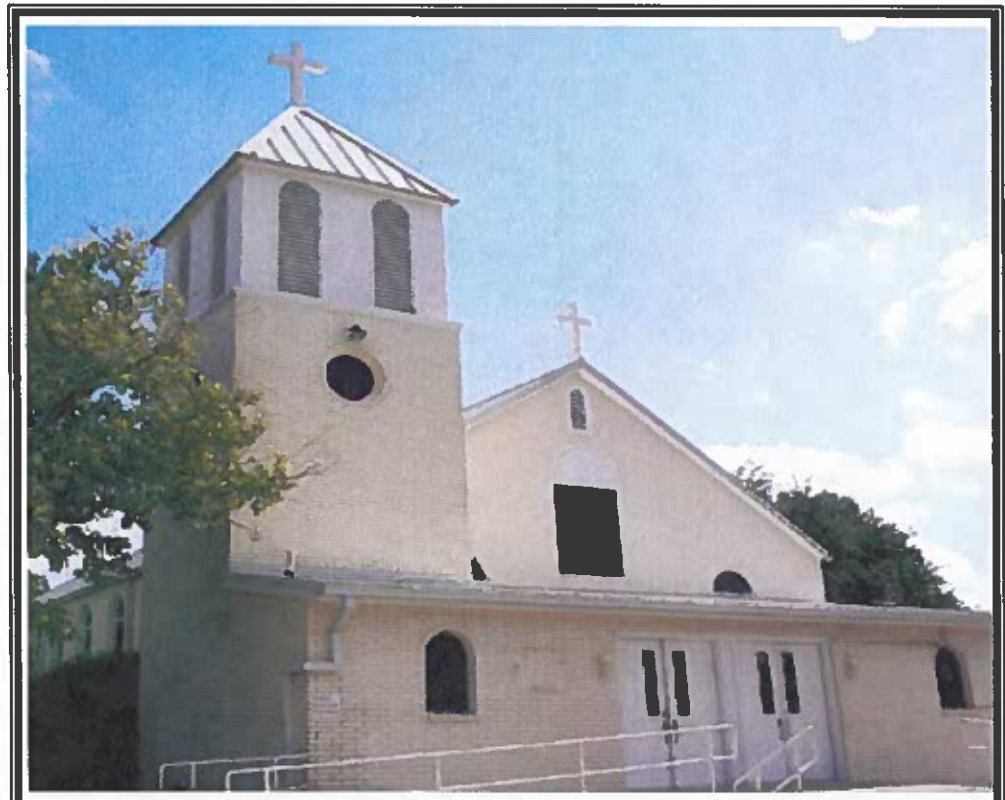


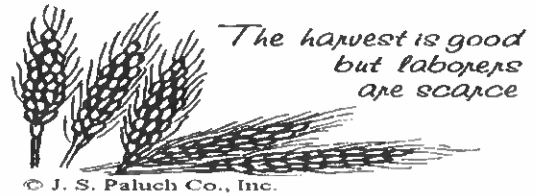

The Requirements for Worthy Receiving Holy Communion.

The best way to participate in the Mass is to receive the Eucharist worthily in Communion. What follows is what the church teaches us about how we must prepare ourselves to receive the Eucharist worthily:

- ❖ We must be baptized;
- ❖ We must be old enough to tell the difference between the Eucharist and ordinary bread;
- ❖ We must know that we are receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus so we receive Communion with reverence and devotion;
- ❖ We must know why we are receiving the Eucharist, not because everyone else is doing it, or because of what others might think if we do not, but in order to please God, to increase our love for God, and to strengthen us;
- ❖ We must ask ourselves if we have committed a mortal sin, and if we have, we must confess our sins to a priest in the Sacrament of Penance;
- ❖ We must also be sorry for any venial sin;
- ❖ We must not eat or drink anything, except water and medicine, for one hour before receiving Holy Communion (this includes such things as chewing gum, coffee, tea, pop, and candy);
- ❖ And, when we go to Mass, we must dress and behave in a way that shows that we know where we are, why we are there, and Who it is that we will receive in Communion.
